I chose to show Alake Shilling and Alex Fisher together because they are two artists who turn to making because it's simply something that they love doing. Art remains for them an outlet and place of exploration. This point of departure puts the artists' interests and emotions at the forefront of the work.

Shilling's works draw inspiration from her own imagination. Her colorful characters and canvases use the language of animation to articulate her emotions. Here she works with painted ceramics to beautiful effect. Her pieces are packed with texture, pastel colors and energetic lines.
